Holidays and Days off in the Republic of Slovenia Act (Official Consolidated Text) (ZPDPD-UPB1)

On the basis of Article 153 of the Rules of Procedure of the National Assembly, the National Assembly of the Republic of Slovenia, in its session of 30 November 2005 certified the Official Consolidated Text of the Holidays and Days off in the Republic of Slovenia Act, which includes:

- Holidays and Days off in the Republic of Slovenia Act – ZPDPD (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia/I, no. 26/91 of 21.11.1991),
- Act Amending the Holidays and Days off in the Republic of Slovenia Act – ZPDPD-A (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, no. 91/05 of 14.10.2005) and
- Correction of the Act Amending the Holidays and Days off in the Republic of Slovenia Act – ZPDPD-A (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, no. 93/05 of 21.10.2005).

**HOLIDAYS AND DAYS OFF IN
THE REPUBLIC OF SLOVENIA
ACT
Official Consolidated Text
(ZPDPD-UPB1)**

Article 1

Holidays in the Republic of Slovenia are:

- 1 and 2 January, New Year
- 8 February, Prešern day, Slovenian Cultural Holiday
- 27 April, Day of Uprising Against Occupation
- 1 and 2 May, May Day Holiday
- 25 June, Statehood Day
- 17 August – Day of Slovenes in Prekmurje Incorporated into the Mother Nation
- 15 September, Day of Restoration of the Primorska Region to the Motherland
- 1 November, All Saints' Day
- 23 November, Rudolf Maister Day
- 26 December Independence and Unity Day

Holidays in the Republic of Slovenia from Paragraph above are Days off, except the Day of Slovenes in Prekmurje Incorporated into the Mother Nation, Day of Restoration of the Primorska Region to the Motherland and Rudolf Maister Day, which are working days.

Article 2

Days off in the Republic of Slovenia are also:

- Easter Sunday and Monday
- Whit Sunday
- 15 August, Assumption Day

-31 October, Reformation Day
-25 December, Christmas

Article 3

Holiday in the Republic of Slovenia or Day off in the Republic of Slovenia, which falls on a Sunday, is not transferred to the following working day.

Holidays and Days off in the Republic of Slovenia Act –ZPDPD (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia/I, no. 26/91) incorporates the following transitional and final provision:

Article 4

On the day this Act enters into force, the Republic Holidays and Days off in the Socialist Republic of Slovenia Act (Official Gazette of the Socialist Republic of Slovenia, no. 33/89) and Holidays of the Socialist Federative Republic of Yugoslavia Act (Official Gazette of the Social Federative Republic of Yugoslavia, no. 6/73) shall cease to be in force.

Article 5

This Act enters into force the day following its publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia.

Act Amending the Holidays and Days off in the Republic of Slovenia Act – ZPDPD-A (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, no. 91/05) incorporates the following final provision:

Article 2

This Act enters into force the day following its publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia.
